Shelter Services

North Star provides shelter in the community that serves up to five families at a time. We offer:

- · Community living environment
- Private bedrooms
- Playroom and playgrounds for children
- Meals and personal hygiene supplies
- Common area, video cameras for safety
- Alcohol, drug and violence-free environment
- WIFI and temperature controlled
- Trauma-sensitive philosophy that offers stress reducing programming such as certified YOGA classes, therapy animal visits, and family game nights

Wellness and Skill Building Trainings

North Star provides an array of weekly trainings that focus on a healthy lifestyle, general well-being and family preservation.

- Group living environment
- Building a budget, saving money and repairing credit
- Resume writing, interviewing techniques, and job search skills
- Landlord/tenant rights
- Nutrition
- Healthy eating on a budget
- Overall wellness and stress management

Case Management and Referral

North Star is with you every step of the way.

- Weekly, on-site case management and daily check-ins
- Staff supported guidance, emotional support, and advocacy towards general sense of HOPE
- Income review and financial accountability
- Resource Directory
- Job and housing assistance
- Service and goal plan model developed in first week
- Random toxicology screens
- Access resources health insurance, mental health referral, substance abuse treatment, day care, food stamps, primary care physicians, etc.

We Need Your Support. North Star is not a Commonwealth, State run shelter but rather is a private, Community Based shelter.

Our shelter operates on an efficient model of three full-time staff members and all agency funds are carefully and thoughtfully managed.

The shelter recently went green and secured a donation of 44 solar panels so our electric power is now provided by the sun.

North Star is in the early planning stages to build a permanent, supportive living community for families in Leominster. We have secured a property with several acres where we are currently conducting due diligence measures prior to applying to the Commonwealth for grant assistance.
